End of Marking Period 3

The end of Marking Period 3, as well as the lovely Spring weather are fast approaching! Make sure you are staying focused and alert during live sessions. Here are a few tips below to maintain your momentum:

- **Be prepared** - gather all your supplies for the day (device, charger, notebook, pen/pencils, calculator) before class.
- **Minimize distractions** - make sure your work area is quiet and well lit.
- **Take Notes** - take notes on the lesson material (ex. Learn About It resources) using a notebook or a file saved to your computer.
- **Talk to your teachers** - let your teachers know when you need help (go to Revisit) or extra time on an assignment (be prepared to explain why).

Marking Period 3 ends on April 5th and all work should be submitted before Spring Break on **March 22nd**.



Spring Testing

MAP (Measure of Academic Performance) and **MCAP** (Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program) Testing will occur during Marking Period 3. Most students will take these tests at their home schools, unless directed otherwise.

- Students **MUST** be in attendance **AND** use a BCPS Device during any major eLearning & district-wide testing activities.
- If you are testing at your home school, be sure to inform your Homeroom and Period teachers.
- Attend daily Revisit sessions during lunch to receive extra support from your teacher when preparing for tests and other assessments.

Contact the School Counselor at your home school if you have not received any information about testing.
