eLearning Reminders

- **MP2 Report Cards** - Marking Period 2 report cards are available for review in FOCUS.
- **MP3 Interim Conferences** - Parent Teacher Conferences for Marking Period 3 will take place on Tuesday, March 27, 2024. Teachers will post information for scheduling conferences on their Schoology pages.
- **Checking Student Progress** - Please check your student's attendance (FOCUS) and grades (Schoology). Parents should use the contact information on each Schoology class page to reach out to teachers for progress updates.
- **Maintaining Routines** - When engaged in eLearning classes, students should be logged into Schoology to access lesson material/assignments and Google Meet for teacher direct instruction and support.

Attendance Matters



Attendance in eLearning classes is mandatory. Any student missing **10%** of the school year is considered **chronically absent**. In order to be marked present, students should have their cameras or use their microphones, so teachers can verify their attendance in live sessions. Each quarter, student attendance and academic progress is reviewed to determine continued enrollment in the program.

Testing Reminders

MAP (Measure of Academic Performance) and **MCAP** (Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program) Testing will occur during Marking Period 3. Most students will take these tests at their home schools, unless directed otherwise.

- Students **MUST** be in attendance **AND** use a BCPS Device during any major eLearning & district-wide testing activities.
- If you are testing at your home school, be sure to inform your Homeroom and Period teachers.
- Attend daily Revisit sessions during lunch to receive extra support from your teacher when preparing for tests and other assessments.
